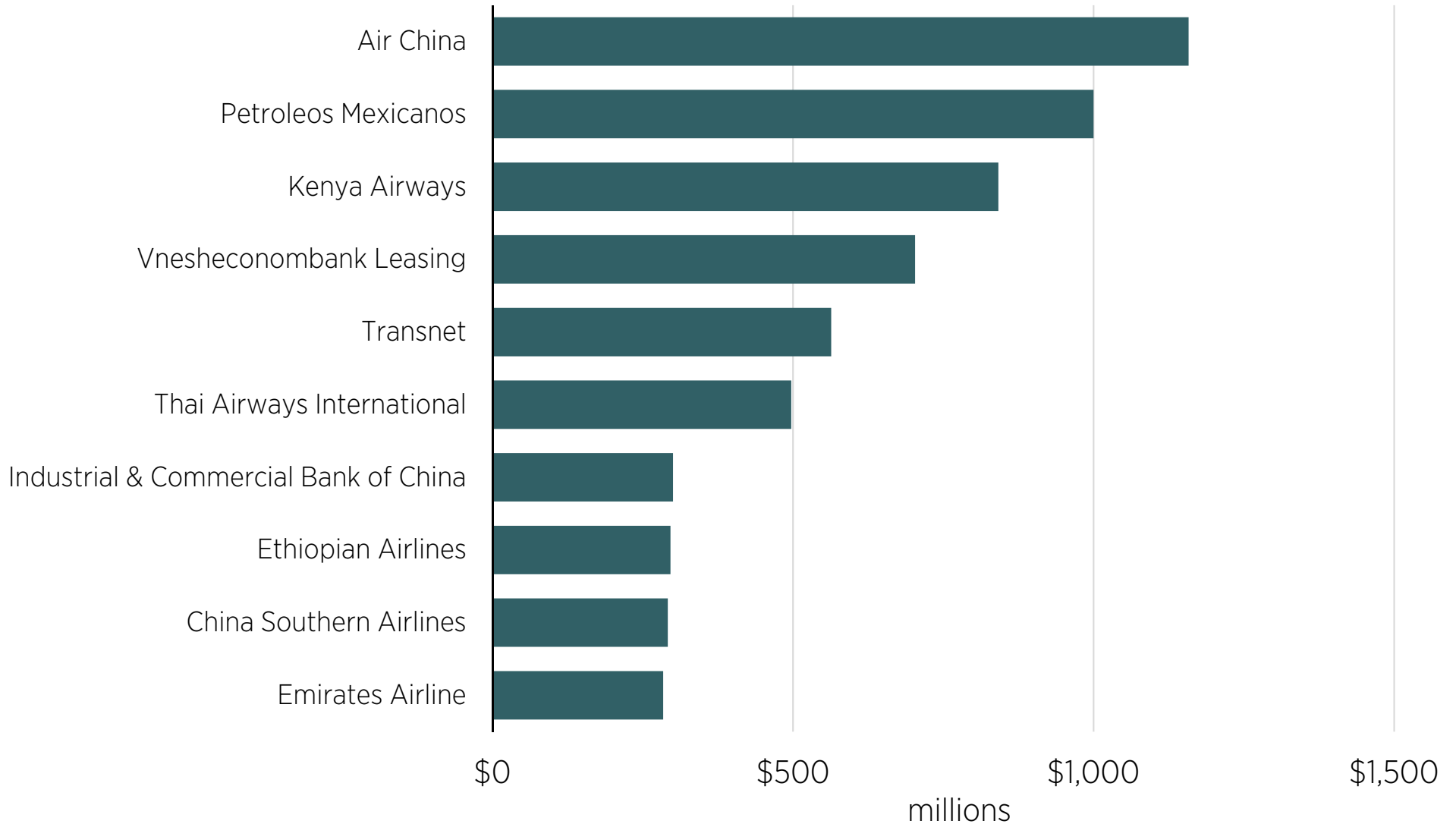


Top 10 State Owned Enterprises & Foreign Government Agencies Receiving Ex-Im Bank Aid (FY 2014)

In 2014 foreign owned airlines were the largest beneficiaries of the Ex-Im Bank.



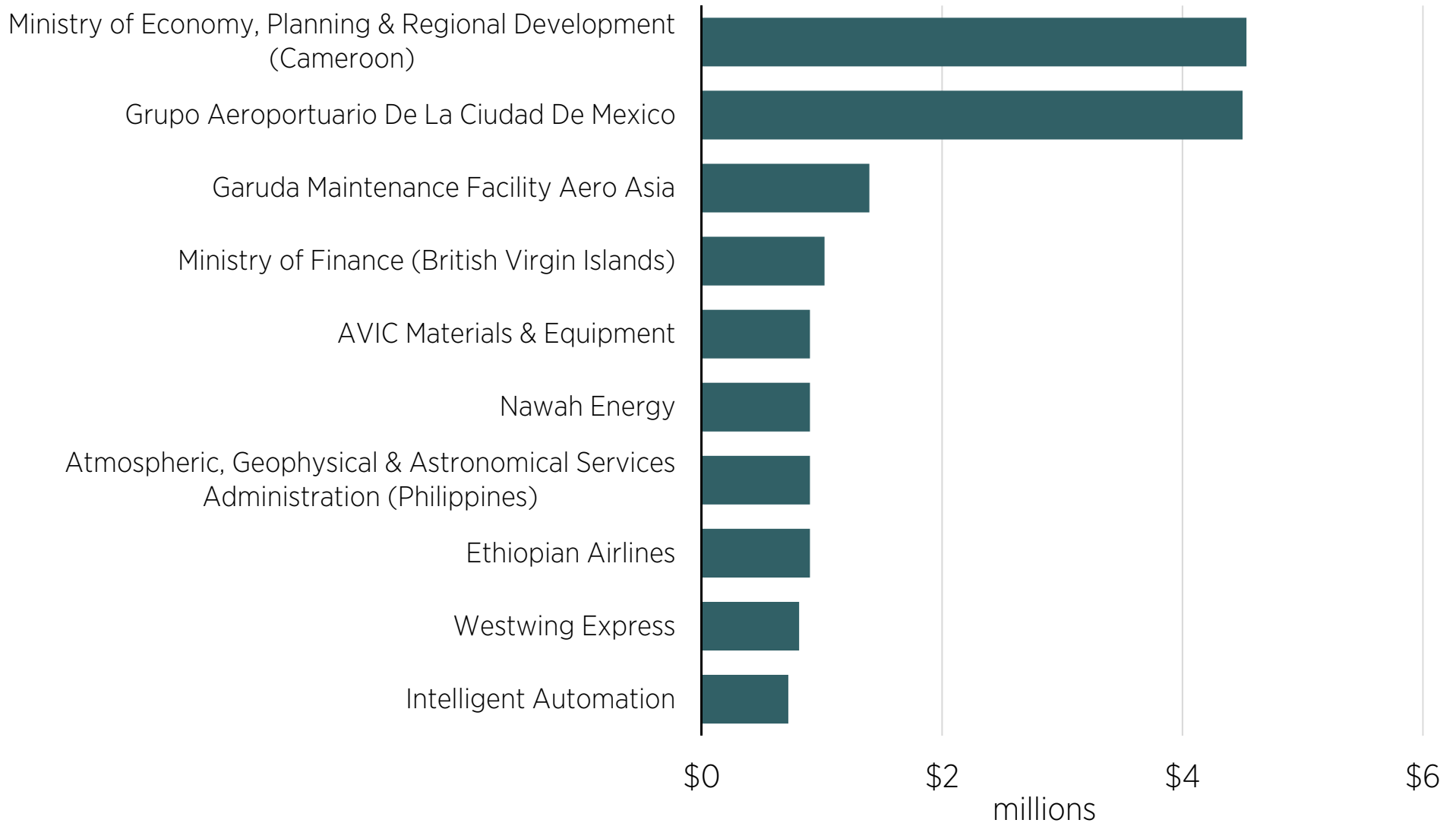

By 2018, foreign government agencies were among the top Ex-Im Bank beneficiaries.



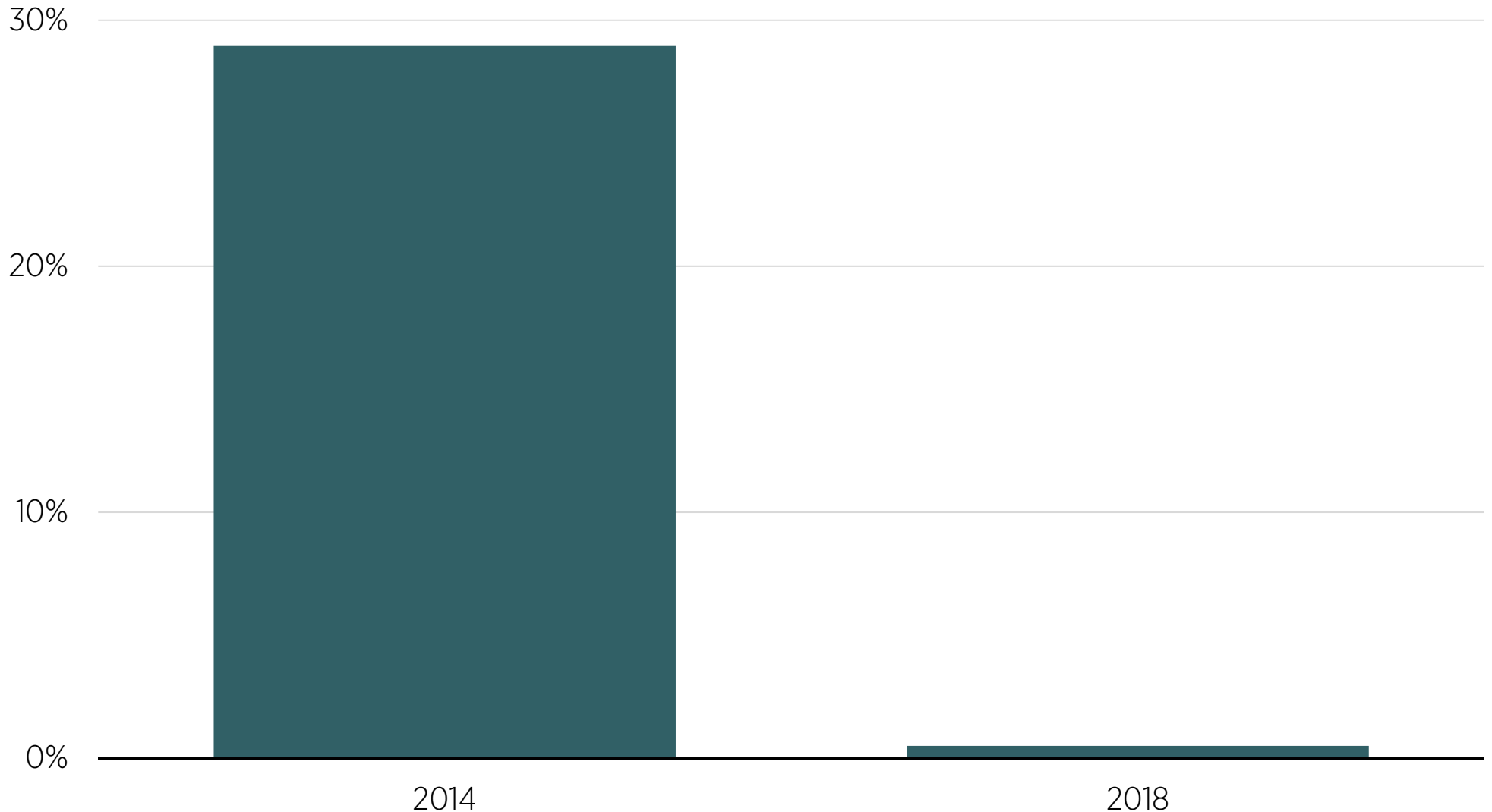
