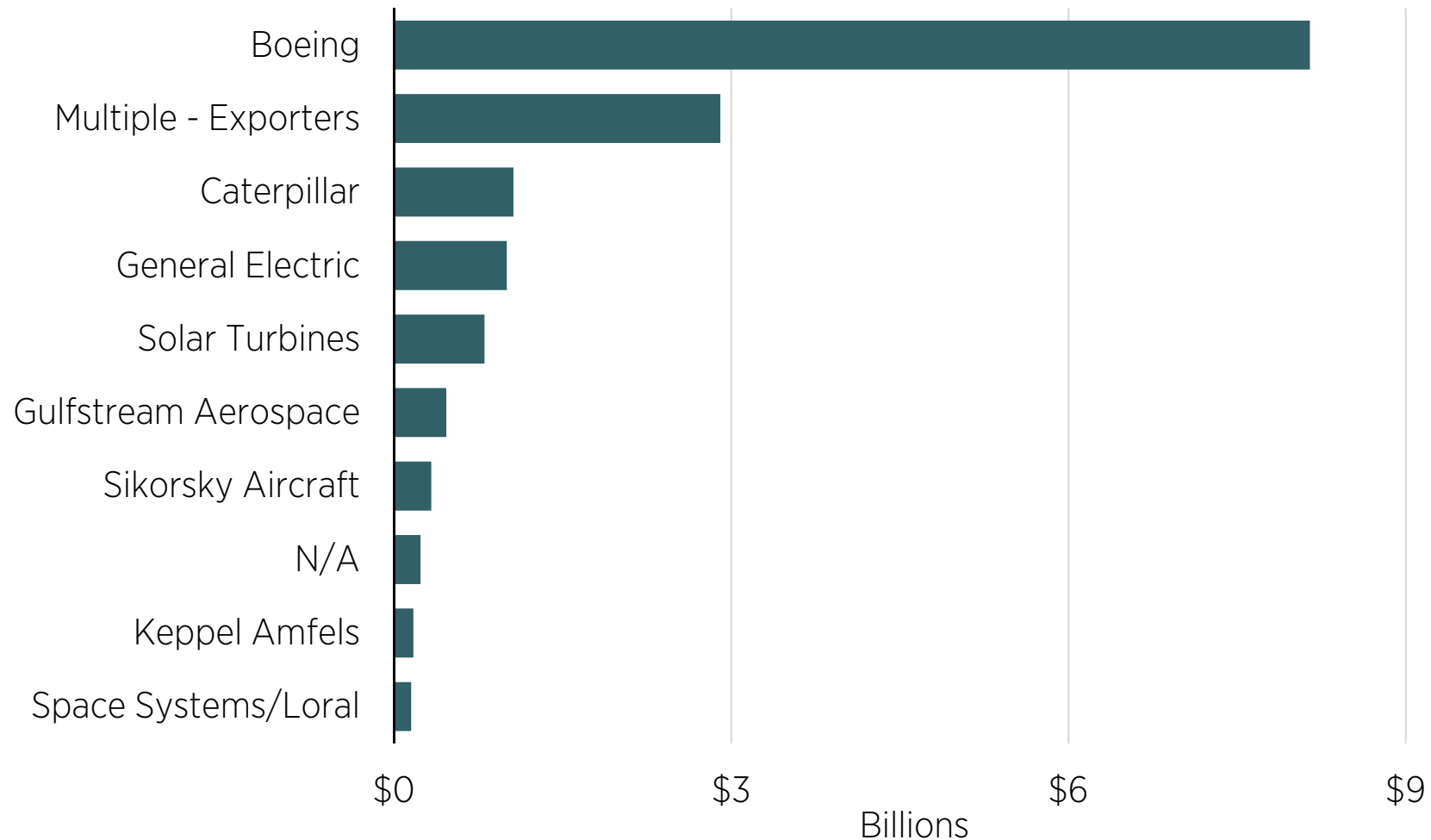


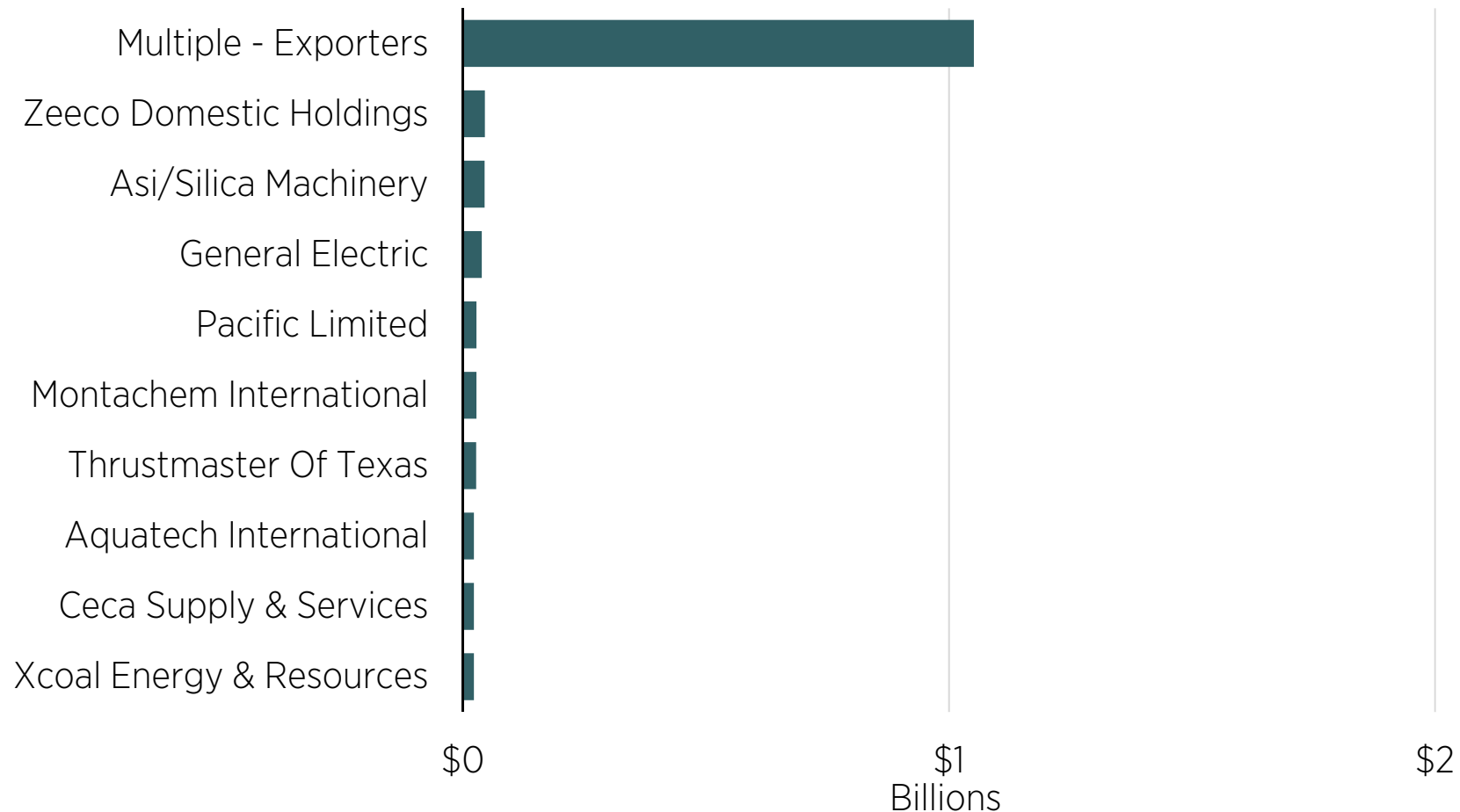
## Top 10 Ex-Im Bank Beneficiaries in 2014

In 2014 Boeing, Caterpillar and General Electric were the top Ex-Im Bank beneficiaries.



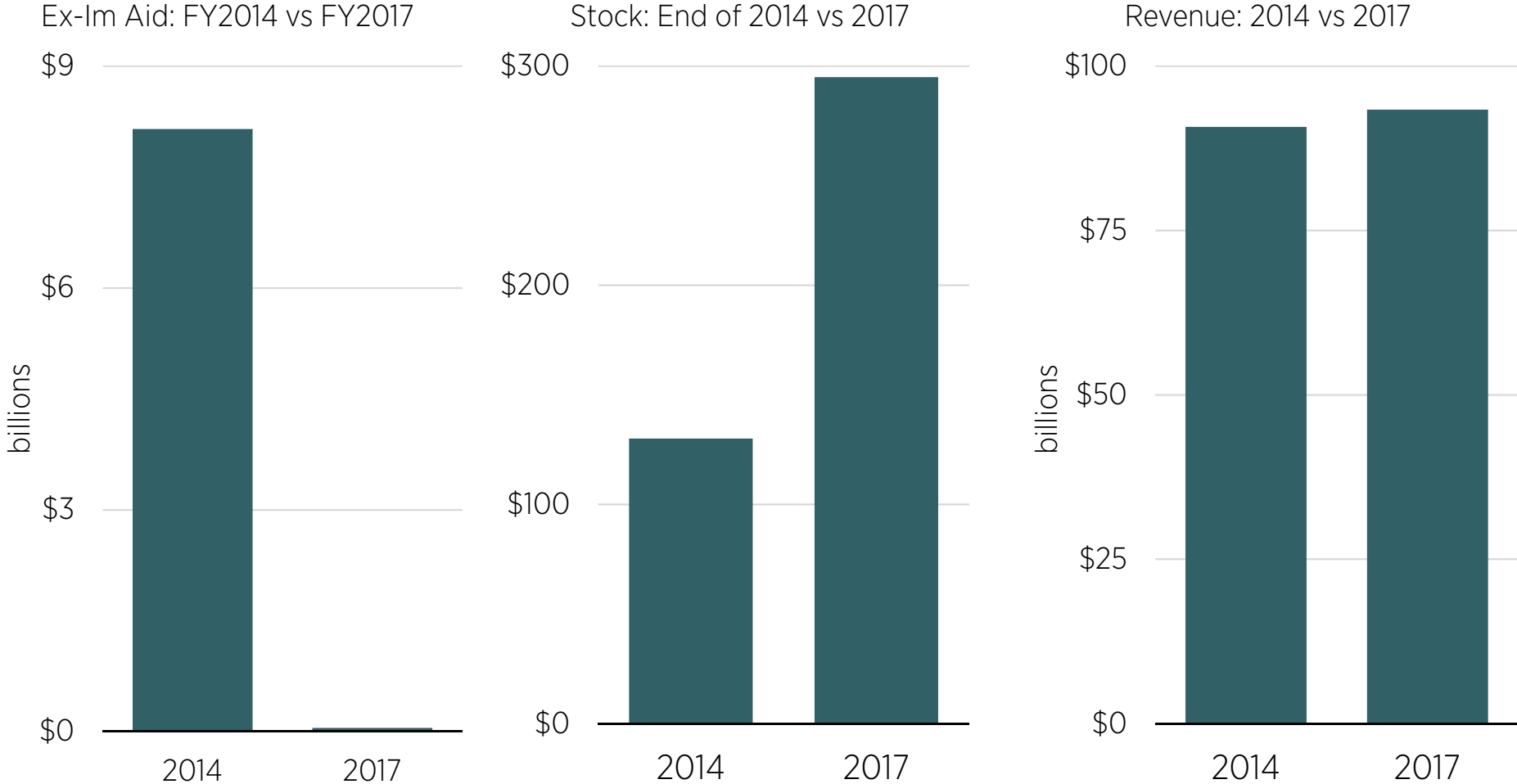
## Top 10 Ex-Im Bank Beneficiaries in 2017

# Boeing 2014 vs 2017: Ex-Im Bank Aid, Stock Value, and Total Revenue

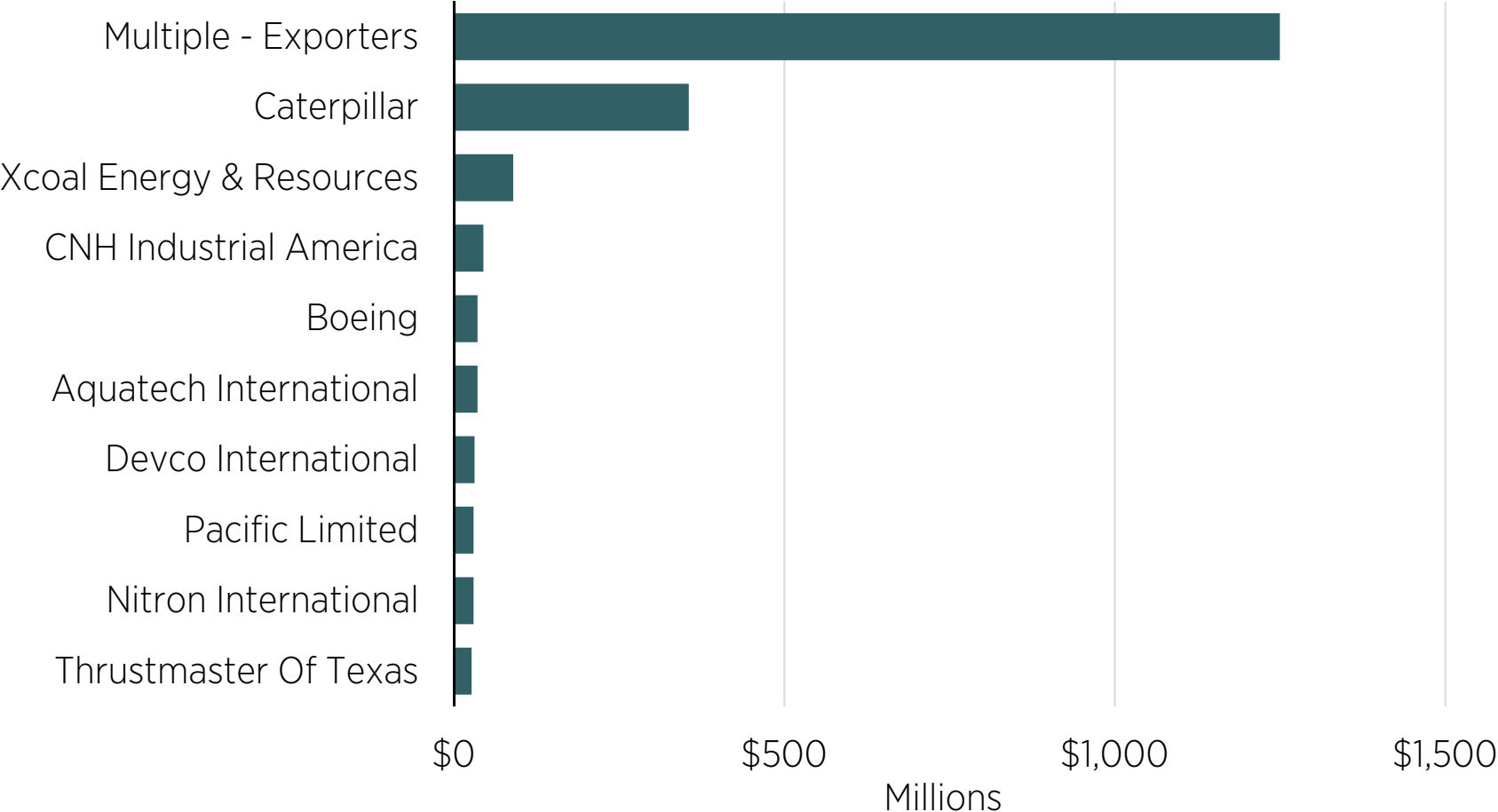
Since 2014 Boeing has lost over 99 percent of its Ex-Im Bank aid, but is still flourishing.

# Top 10 Small Business Authorizations by The Ex-Im Bank in 2014

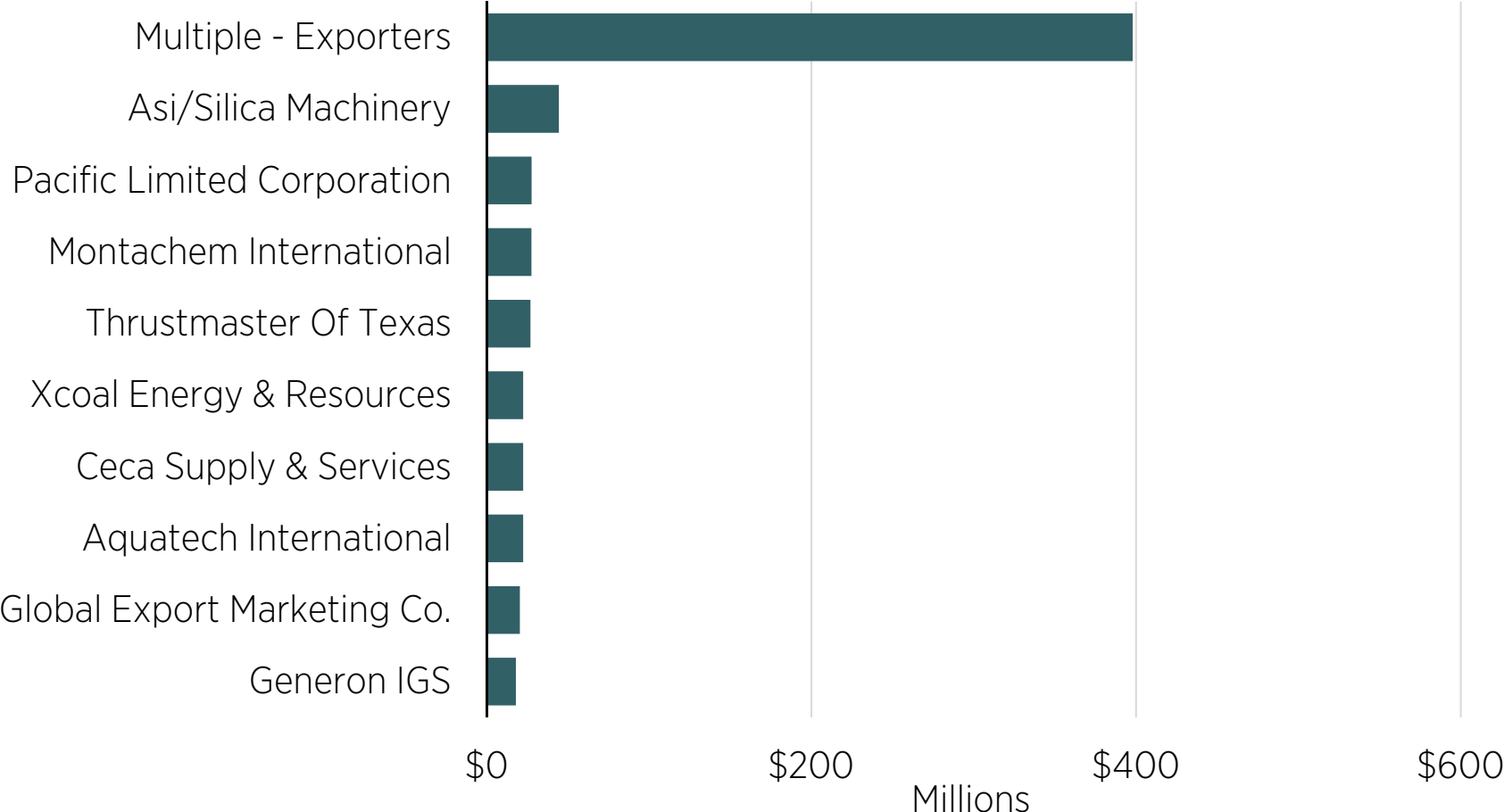
Caterpillar and Boeing rank in the top recipients of small business aid from the Ex-Im bank, despite being multi-billion dollar companies.
